“LOOKING UP AND OUTWARD”

What does it mean to have the right doctrine in all matters concerning God? I know doctrine is important, however, as I read Matthew 25:31-46, it seems as if Jesus is not conducting the final judgment concerning the belief of the people but rather how those beliefs were acted upon. The importance of doctrine seems to rest on how they motivate us to action rather than just having a set of correct beliefs. I have come to the conclusion that right doctrine is as useless as a car without an engine if those doctrines are not translated into actions. In Matthew 25, Jesus did not ask those people what they believed about taking care of the needs of others, he pointed out the response and motivation behind those beliefs. One group became so like Jesus in nature that they were acting on those beliefs without even recognizing it. The other group argued they did the right thing, but Jesus pointed out that it was all for the wrong reason. Right doctrine not only changes my actions, they also change my attitude in serving God, by serving others. Read Matthew 25:31-46 and think about it!

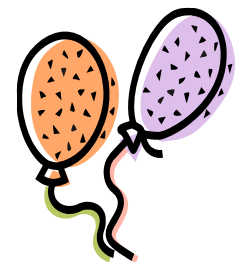
