"LOOKING UP AND OUTWARD"

What does it mean to be a Christian? This is a question I have often asked in class settings and the answers were all across the spectrum. When I would ask this question of a young group (such as my LCU Bible Class) the answers were more focused on what people did, and how faith was lived out in doing good for others (action). When I would ask an older group, such as in an adult bible class setting, the answers were more focused on identity, which group you belonged to, and they included actions, but were more focused on church assemblies. It did not take long for me to understand that there is a huge gap between the way younger and older groups of Christians defined Christianity. Is there a way to close that gap? Is there a way the church can address such differences in how each group defines Christianity and bring them closer together? I say "yes, it is in the truth, proper understanding, and application of God's word". I have concluded that both groups need to understand that Christianity is action, born out of love for God, His Son and His Word. James said faith without works is dead, but Paul also said in Galatians that works born out of legalism is also worthless. I came to the conclusion that maybe both groups needed to read James and Galatians. Read I Chronicles 12:32 and think about the statement concerning the sons of Issachar. What do you think?

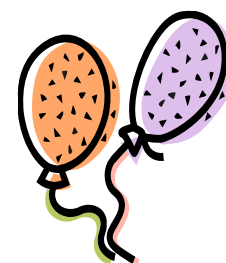
