"LOOKING UP AND OUTWARD"

It seems like every time I read a familiar story or passage from the scriptures, I discover something that I had missed the time before. There are times that I wonder if God intentionally designed the scriptures that way. I believe He did so that we would never stop learning from Him. As an example, the material I am presenting on Sunday mornings and Sunday evenings are from two classes that I prepared about 7 years ago for my Bible classes at LCU. Just last week when I was preparing the lesson that is going to be presented next Sunday morning concerning the life of Abraham, something hit me about the story in Genesis 17:20 that I had never paid close attention to before. That is why I mentioned it in last week's lesson. The text promises that Ishmael would have 12 sons who would father 12 tribes! And the fulfillment of that promise is recorded in Genesis 25:12-16. Now, why is that that something to go "wow" over? Little did Abram and Sarai imagine that their shortcut would originate a conflict that would run until today...but more...the thought came to me that how one decisions today (either good or bad) can effect generations to come! Just think, our decisions today can have an effect on our future children, grandchildren and generations to come. If God's will and God's ways are not important to me today, why should they be important to them tomorrow? It seems to answer a question I have had about Ex. 20:4-6, that makes what we are doing today, recognizing our High School graduates even more important. We all, as a family, have had a part in sharing the love of God and the message of Christ with these young men and women, and today as their family, we tell them "We Love them With the Love of the Lord", now "Go into your future with the Lord". 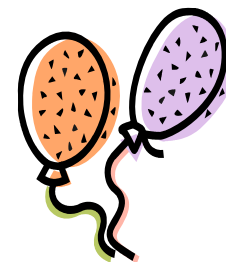
