Newcomers may not know of the Western Hills support of Glynn Langston in his ministry to the visually impaired the world over. Glynn and his wife, Ann, now live in Louisiana just north of Lafayette after spending 21 years in the ministry in France, Belgium, Switzerland, and Ireland. Although blind himself since birth, Glynn travels alone and preaches, writes, and teaches via the internet and shortwave radio in French, Russian, Spanish, and Italian. In addition, he ships printed Bibles, Braille Bibles and literature, audiocassettes, and Courier Talking Bibles in various languages to countries throughout the world. One of his more successful efforts in terms of baptisms is Bible camps for the blind in India. Glynn supports two Indian preachers who actually conduct the camps, and the supplies all teaching materials. The most recent of these camps had 100 attendees and resulted in 11 baptisms. Glynn's annual trip to Ireland to strengthen the churches there has been delayed this year due to medical problems and the atmospheric ash from the volcano in Iceland; he hopes to go late in July. Please write or e-mail Glynn and Ann to encourage them in their work.
